RoomMate – a revolutionary safety sensor designed to solve current and future care challenges for the benefit of both residents and healthcare staff.

RoomMate is three tools in one

- 1 Automatic notification** of potentially hazardous situations such as if the resident sits up in their bed, leaves their bed, leaves or enters the room, falls, or calls out for help, all without any wearables
- 2 Anonymous digital monitoring** supports residents' privacy and allows you to check up on and even talk to the resident, and thus quickly decide if your physical presence is needed.
- 3 Activity monitoring** – identify unusual activity such as restless sleeping, frequent toilet visits or excessive bed rest. This provides you with unique decision support and enables individual care and treatment.

What are the benefits of RoomMate?

For the resident

- Fewer falls, fewer injuries and ailments
- Better sleep due to fewer physical inspections
- More privacy



For care providers

- Less stress and fewer sick leaves
- More time for personal care

- Reduces digital fatigue – RoomMate is a multi-sensor that replaces numerous other sensors and reduces the overall need for cleaning, maintenance, logistics and configuration



Technical functionality

- Power supply and access to the internet are the only two things required for RoomMate to work.
- RoomMate can connect to the internet via an Ethernet cable, Wi-Fi or through a mobile data connection. An external 3G/4G router is needed if using mobile data.
- RoomMate has low demands in terms of its internet connection. Data usage is below 100 kB/s during active supervision. In addition, RoomMate uses less than 20MB per day to maintain contact with the rest of the RoomMate system.
- RoomMate is developed on the principle of privacy by design and follows the recommendations set out in the Norm for Information Security (Norwegian). Among other things, this means anonymized images, full traceability for all use and all processing of alerts is performed by the sensor itself.
